



Now there are more Beachviews

HOTONDO Homes' newest display home, the Beachview, is now available in two new size options.

The popular Beachview 340 design, on display at 1 Nautical Rise, Torquay, showcases the best of contemporary coastal living.

It has 35.8 squares of living space as well as three separate outdoor areas for those who love to entertain.

However, there are now two newer versions of the popular design, the Beachview 280 and the Beachview 382.

As displayed, the Beachview 340 comprises three bed-

rooms, a rumpus room, a large open-plan kitchen, dining and living area and two bathrooms.

For those after a more spacious contemporary home, the Beachview 382 is the best option.

This design includes a fourth bedroom on the lower level as well as extra storage space on both levels, including a walk-in linen cupboard

All three designs feature open-plan living on the top level with a light-filled kitchen, dining and living area that opens out to a balcony at the front and a deck at the rear, allowing inside and outside living to combine into one large space.

Fixed-price contracts are also given before the con-

struction of the home gets underway.
